



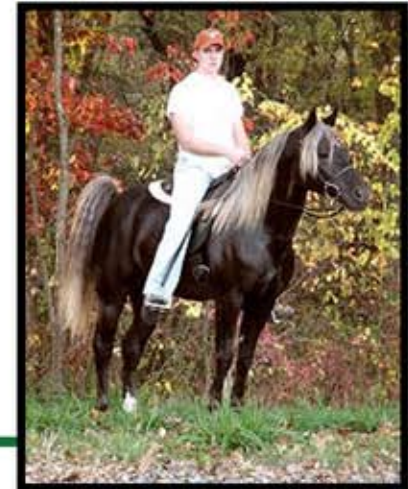
Joe Banjo
